SCHOOL GROUP INFORMATION FOR 1792 JOHANNES MUELLER HOUSE TOUR

In 1756 the Moravian's established a closed Congregational Settlement in Lititz Pennsylvania. In 1961, a dedicated group of Lititz citizens combined their efforts to preserve the rich history of the area with the purchase of the Johannes Mueller House and later the Christian Schropp House establishing the Lititz Historical Foundation.

The museum, housed in the 1793 Christian Schropp home, provides the visitor a history of the evolution of Lititz through plaques in the timeline room. Other displays throughout the building exhibit the rich history of Lititz over the years.

Our Gift Shop offers items of historic nature, many of which are hand made in the area or within Pennsylvania.

Next door, one of our costumed docents will guide you through the Johannes Mueller House with a glimpse of life of the local tradesman and his family living in a closed community in the 18th century.

Fees:

- **\$4.50 per person** – No charge for group organizer or bus driver. Due upon the day of the tour.

Reservation Fee: Due Upon Submission of this Agreement with the Lititz Historical Foundation: \$25.00

Tours:

- The tour of the Lititz Museum and Johannes Mueller House is approximately 2 hours total. Keep this in mind when planning your tour if you are visiting other points of interest or have meal reservations.
- The Museum is self guided; the Johannes Mueller House is led by a costumed docent as your personal tour guide.

- Tour groups of 20+ persons will be divided into smaller groups to tour the Johannes Mueller House.
- The normal Johannes Mueller House tour includes the second floor bedrooms by way of a steep staircase.

This second floor is not handicap accessible and visitors do not have to include the second floor on the tour.

Restrooms:

- There is one restroom located in the Museum building which is handicap accessible. Two other restrooms are available in the Carriage House on North Lane behind museum. These are NOT handicap accessible.

Bus Parking:

- On Main Street across from the Museum at 145 E. Main Street
- Public parking area on N. Water Street approximately ½ block behind the Museum. This is a gravel lot.
- Museum parking area behind the property on North Lane for a small bus.
- The back of Lititz Springs Park. Enter at the Welcome Center from N. Broad Street. The park is located approximately 4 blocks from the Museum.
- Please inform the Group Tour Coordinator of parking needs before your arrival.
